16:00-17:00 Visit of the **Boyana Church** is a <u>medieval Bulgarian Orthodox</u> church situated on the outskirts of <u>Sofia</u>, the capital of <u>Bulgaria</u>, in the <u>Boyana</u> quarter. The east wing of the two-storey church was originally constructed in the late 10th or early 11th century, then the central wing was added in the 13th century under the <u>Second Bulgarian Empire</u>, the whole building being finished with a further expansion to the west in the middle of the 19th century. Vitosha has the outlines of an enormous dome. The territory of the mountain includes Vitosha <u>national park</u> that encompasses the best known and most frequently visited parts. The foothills of Vitosha shelter resort quarters of Sofia; Knyazhevo quarter has <u>mineral springs</u>.
